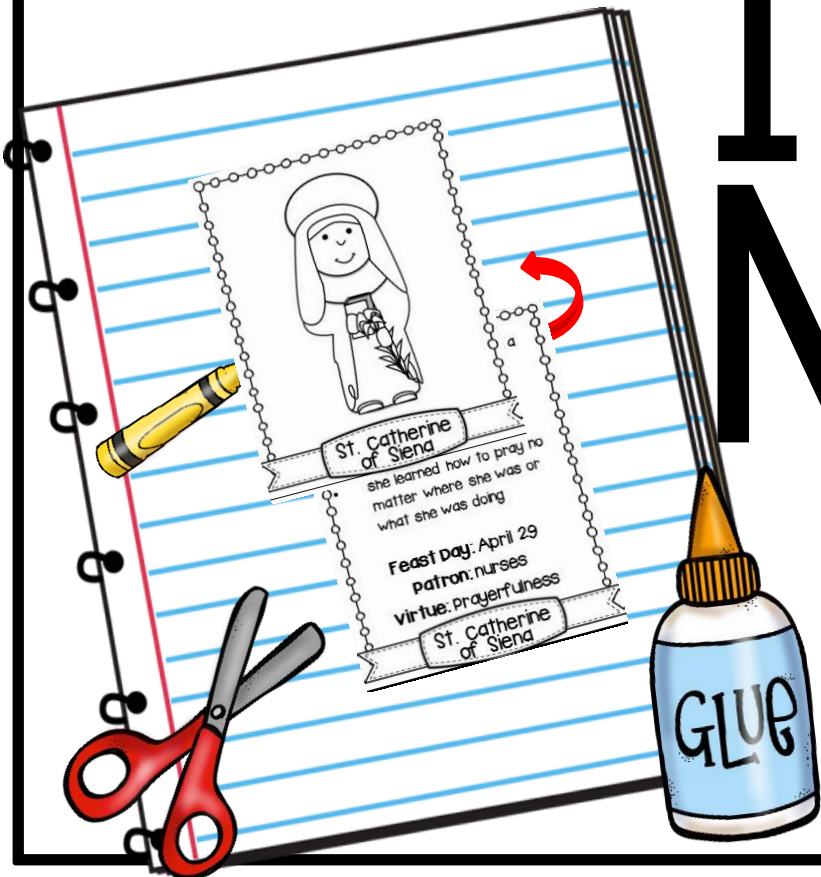

A word about virtues:

The after school religious education program at my parish has recently implemented the teaching of the virtues. The program we are using is called Disciple of Christ: Education in Virtue by Sister John Dominic Rasmussen, O.P. The program breaks down the virtues into theological virtues, cardinal virtues, gifts of the Holy Spirit, and fruits of the Holy Spirit. In her resources, Sr. John Dominic gave the virtues listed for some of the following saints and I followed her same format and vocabulary for the others. While many saints could be described using multiple virtues, I've listed only one for each saint and tried to make it vocabulary that an elementary student could understand. That being said, most virtues will probably need some explanation. - Glue to the top of the description page to make a "flippable" resource

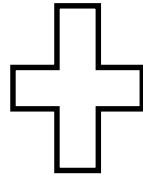
